Rider Education:

GWRRA Rider Education Levels Program

The motorcycle community is already realizing many positive benefits from the GWRRA Rider Education Program. Through the efforts of the Rider Education Officers and participation of the membership and others, we will reach our goal of establishing the safest motorcycle environment possible.

Level 1: Safety by Commitment - The first big step to success.

Level 1 of the Rider Education Program is also referred to as safe miles. It represents the commitment of the Rider and/or the Co-Rider to practice safe motorcycle operation whenever they operate their motorcycle.

Safety is a state of mind, which can only be attained through total commitment.

Every successful accomplishment begins with a commitment to reach the intended objective. This is true of the Rider Education Program and includes a promise to learn for the sake of the Rider, Co-Rider, friends and family, and others on the road.

Though there is no mileage requirement to enter Level 1, the commitment to safe riding is tracked by the number of accident free miles since joining GWRRA. Accident free miles are accumulated in 5,000-mile increment and may be updated at yearly intervals.

Requirement: Verbal commitment to ride safely at all times. No cost to sign up.

Always ride within your limits and the limits of your Trike/Bike. If you are tired, stop. Maintain your following distance and

use your mental riding strategies effectively. Be prepared and aware.

Some ways we can lower the risk associated with rid-

ing is by obtaining and using rider training skills and techniques and, most of all, by developing and using a good defensive riding strategy. The most important element of riding is the mental skills and techniques. The physical aspect is important but is generally used to get us out of trouble when the mental strategies have failed.


